The Brookline Housing Authority will be accepting applications for two and three-bedroom federal family public housing beginning **November 9th, 8:30 AM through December 4th, 1 PM**. Eligible applicants will be placed in random order on the appropriate wait list. Date and time of applications will not be considered. Applications received after 1 PM, December 4th will not be accepted. The waiting period for housing depends on local preferences, priorities and the number of vacancies in our developments.
